

Sixth Grade Supply List 2010-2011

- Scissors (no shears)
- Pencils – 3 packs of a dozen (mechanical allowed with extra lead)
- 1 package pens, blue or black ink
- 4 highlighters, any color
- 1 package colored pencils
- 1 zipper pouch for pencils, pens, and markers
- Pencil sharpener (enclosed, hand-held)
- Notebook paper – 2 packs of 250 (may need to purchase more mid year)
- Graph paper – 1 pack of 100 (no spirals please)
- 1 3-inch 3-ring binder w/dividers or accordion organizer
- Dictionary – standard paperback (Random House or Webster)
- 3 boxes of family-sized tissue (no lotion/perfume)
- 1 box of baby wipes (unscented)
- Boys: 1 box Ziploc baggies (quart size) – generic brand is fine
- Girls: 1 box Ziploc baggies (gallon size) – generic brand is fine

Art Supplies:

- 1 plastic pocket folder
- 2 black sharpies (fine point)
- 1 white block eraser

Spanish:

- 1 spiral notebook
- 1 green plastic pocket folder

Gym Clothes (6th-8th grade only)

- These clothes do NOT need to be purchased at Dennis Uniforms.
- They should consist of a plain, one-colored T-shirt. Shirts that are worn for gym must have sleeves...NO tanks!
- Plain, one-colored gym shorts, i.e. soccer shorts
