

## Seventh and Eight Grade Supply List 2010-2011

Please label all supplies with your child's name except Art supplies

- 1 package of pens – blue or black ink only. Gel pens are not allowed
- 1 large package of #2 pencils
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 package of colored pencils (12 or more)
- 1 glue stick
- 1 box of thin markers
- 2 boxes of tissues
- One 2" – 3-ring binder for Science and Math
- One 2" – 3-ring binder for History and Language Arts
- Notebook dividers for each binder
- 5 plastic pocket folders for Language Arts
- 2 marble folders
- 2 packages of filler paper, college ruled, 200 sheets or more
- 1 package of Lysol wipes
- 1 package paper cups or napkins

#### 7<sup>th</sup> grade:

- 1 plastic pocket folder
- 2 black sharpies (fine point)
- 1 white block eraser
- 9X12 sketchpad (this item will be labeled with the student's name and will be used from year to year – they may use the same one as last year)

#### 8<sup>th</sup> grade:

- 1 plastic pocket folder
- 2 black sharpies (ultra fine point)

### Gym Clothes (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade only)

- These clothes do NOT need to be purchased at Dennis Uniforms
- They should consist of a plain, one-colored T-shirt. Shirts that are worn for gym must have sleeves...NO tanks!
- Plain, one-colored gym shorts, i.e. soccer shorts
- Shorts should be modest, not sagging below the waist or short-shorts
